This information is especially important to schools, because reducing risk factors and increasing protective factors is correlated with increased student achievement. The survey is provided FREE OF CHARGE to all public and private Kansas school districts for administration to 6th, 8th, 10th and 12th grade students between Dec. 1 and Jan. 31, and takes one class period to administer.
