
2024 KCTC COUNTY PARTICIPATION OPTIONAL SUICIDE / DEPRESSION MODULE





The Kansas Communities That Care (KCTC) Student Survey is one of the only tools available to assess current perceptions, opinions, attitudes, and behaviors of youth in Kansas. These perceptions in turn, reflect the health and well-being of our families, schools, and communities. However, the survey data will only give an accurate picture of students' experiences if the majority of Kansas schools participate. District administrators and teachers must stress the value and importance of the KCTC survey and commit to survey administration.

The KCTC Student Survey is administered at no charge to all Kansas schools. In the 2023 session, there were over 32,900 students who took the survey in 179 school districts and private schools, representing 22% of eligible participants. Be a part of the largest student survey in the state—your school's participation is crucial.

The KCTC Student Survey has been administered annually by Greenbush throughout the state since 1994-95 with funding by the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services, Behavioral Health Services Commission.
